

Palliative Care Training



Volunteers working directly with our residents and families must complete a 30 hour Palliative Care Training Program led by qualified Hospice facilitators as outlined by Hospice Palliative Care Ontario (HPCO). Our program prepares volunteers with the tools and education to provide the best care possible to our residents and families. Facilitators use a variety of methods such as group discussion, storytelling, multimedia and invite guest speakers to enhance the learning experience.

The training covers such topics as

- Role of the Volunteer
- What is palliative care
- Effective Communication skills
- Philosophy and Goals of End of Life Care
- Grief and Bereavement
- Emotional, Physical and Spiritual Support

We provide volunteer training for the volunteer team specific to the role you wish to fulfill. A shorter, tailored training program is provided for volunteers who do not wish to work directly with our residents and families (i.e. gardeners, maintenance, fundraising, etc). All volunteers must undergo a criminal record check.
